Before Intravenous Anesthesia Sedation

- You may not have anything to eat or drink (including water) for six (6) hours prior to the appointment.
- No smoking (any substance) at least 3 days before IV or general sedation. Ideally, cut down or stopsmoking as soon as possible prior to the day of surgery.
- 3. A responsible adult must accompany the patient to the office, remain in the office during the procedure, and drive the patient home.
- 4. The patient should not drive a vehicle or operate any machinery for 24 hours following the anesthesia experience.
- 5. Please wear loose fitting clothing with sleeves which can be rolled up pastthe elbow, and low-heeled shoes.
- 6. Contact lenses, jewelry, and dentures must be removed at the time of surgery.
- 7. Do not wear lipstick, excessive makeup, or nail polish on the day ofsurgery.
- 8. If you have an illness such as a cold, sore throat, stomach or bowelupset, please notify the office.
- 9. If you take routine oral medications, please check with the doctor prior to your surgical date for instructions.
